Innovate

Innovate funding must avoid market completion with existing investors

Record investment levels in UK life sciences companies but at late Series A / Series B.

We aim to address a 'market failure' at pre-seed / seed for innovative high risk projects/companies

State Aid legislation typically means we can ONLY work in pre-market space

SMART grant funding competition

For businesses in any sector

- enables businesses to apply for grant funding regardless of technical or industrial area of focus
- funding for the best proposals in a competitive application process
- 4 open competitions run in 2019/20, offering a total of £100 million funding

SBRI: Digital Regulatory Navigation Platform (Health Products)

- £3million competition to develop proof of principle digital regulatory navigation platform
- Particular focus on MDR, IVDR and UKCA
- enable users to understand and explore the regulatory pathways for the product.
- provide users with information and access to UK support structures that are relevant to their commercial R&D, for example, standards, UKAS accredited test labs, and Notified Bodies
- Collaboration with GMDN, SNOMED CT and UKAS
